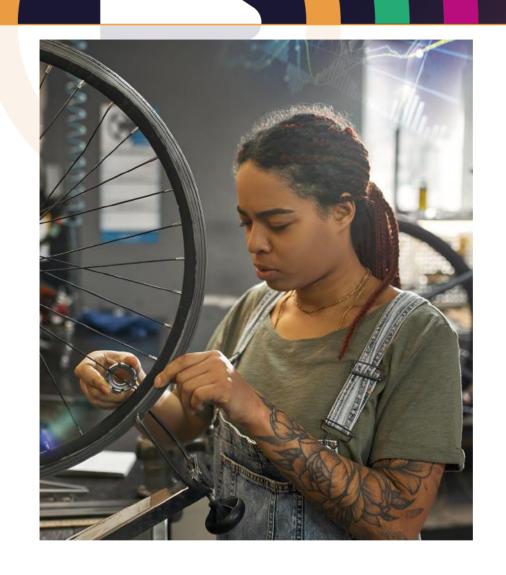

# UK cycle industry: Strategy for growth and jobs

- Contributes £7.5 bn p.a. to the UK economy
- Supports 64,000 green jobs
- Electrification of transport: "The future is electric"





### **UK cycle industry: The evidence case**

- Low carbon alternative
  - For 5% of personal journeys
  - and 15% of urban van miles
- 'Green' light electric alternative for 1.5 billion car kilometres
- Minimum environmental impact

- Germany, Italy, France (Plan Vélo)

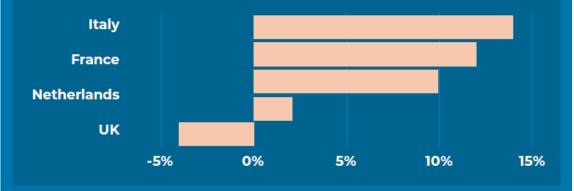

# **Accelerate uptake of EAPCs**

### E-bike unit sales: UK vs. France Subsidy starts in France France 750,000 500,000 250,000 0





- The value of the German e-bike market has quadrupled in a decade from circa €2 bn in 2012 to €7.36 bn in 2022
- EU e-bike manufacture has seen sustained growth (24% in 2021, 19% in 2022).



# Accelerate uptake of EAPCs

- One million more people
- Voucher scheme for:
   e-bikes, e-cargo, specialist bikes
- Targeted incentives:
   business mileage, scrappage schemes





# UK cycle industry: Objective 2 Widen access to mobility

- Zero VAT on children's bikes
- Fund Bikeability for <u>every</u> child
- Zero VAT on cycles as mobility aids





# Widen access to mobility

#### Zero VAT on children's bikes:

- Only 22% of children cycle regularly
- Children's cycles sales decline 31% (vs 2019)
- 25% of children (ages 5-10) don't have access to a bike
- Children's clothes, shoes, helmets are zero-rated





## **Growth and jobs**

- Aim: integrated transport and industrial strategies
- Aim: boost and widen access to mobility for all groups and generations
- Aim: invigorate high streets
- Aim: deliver electrification fast
